Medically trained members have drawn up a list of items needed to treat serious war injuries. The initiative can rely on a network of Polish and Ukrainian supporters for the transport to Ukraine and has already organised and transported several runs of donations in kind to Poland and Ukraine in recent weeks.

Under the motto #bettertogether, all employees of AL-KO Vehicle Technology in Germany were also able to make their contribution: with a voluntary salary donation, i.e. by waiving payment of parts of their remuneration or parts of an accumulated hourly quota on a working time account. These donations went to the International Red Cross.
